Real Estate Property Tax Exemption

Clause 22F

Exemption amount: **FULL**
Application & Required Documents on or before **April 1, 2026**

For Qualifying Veterans with:

- Paraplegics or **100% disability** for service-connected blindness
- Spouses (where veteran's spouse owns the domicile) or surviving spouse of veterans entitled to exemption under Clause 22F

REQUIREMENTS:

- ☐ **NEW APPLICANTS: DD214 & VA Certification letter on service-connected disability** or for surviving spouse, letter pertaining to deceased spouse from the U.S. Department of Veteran's Affairs (VA) *(Most Veterans receive a letter from the VA in June of each year)*
- ☐ **Must own and occupy the property as of July 1 of the tax year and:**
 - Domiciled in Massachusetts 6 consecutive months before entering military
Or lived in Massachusetts for 5 years before July 1st
 - Certification of a service-connected disability or death from the U.S. Department of Veteran's Affairs (VA) *(Most Veterans receive a letter from the VA in June of each year)*
 - ***All applicants** that are 100% disabled must supply the Certification letter **each year** with the annual signed application
- ☐ **Signed Application**-Mailed each year to repeat applicants.

If you **return** the application & required documents by **December 1, 2025**
The exemption amount will be reflected on a certificate and your January 2026 tax bill.
If the exemption application is approved after the paid tax bill, the abated amount will be mailed.
