SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the **Oxford High School, 100 Carbuncle Drive** in said Oxford on **Wednesday, October 8, 2025 at 7:00 p.m.**, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds and appropriate a sum of money to pay unpaid bills of a prior fiscal year; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise by taxation or transfer from available funds and appropriate a sum of money to the Capital Stabilization Fund; or act thereon.

Sponsored by the Finance Director and Town Manager

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise by taxation or transfer from available funds and appropriate a sum of money to the Stabilization Fund, for Fiscal Year 2026; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise by taxation or transfer from available funds, and appropriate a sum of money for unforeseen health insurance-related expenses; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000 (Fifty Thousand Dollars) from certified Free Cash into the Special Education Reserve Fund, established by ratification vote taken under Article 2 at the October 3, 2018 Special Town Meeting; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise by taxation or transfer from available funds, and appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of developing and completing a comprehensive Master Plan for the Town, including all costs incidental and related thereto; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to repeal from the Town Bylaws, Chapter 62, Regulations of Cats; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to accept the provisions of G. L. c.138, §12D, which, if accepted, would allow the Board of Selectmen as the local licensing authority of the Town, to approve a request from a licensee to convert an existing license to sell wines and malt beverages only for on-premises consumption to a license to sell all alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption, subject to all other provisions of G.L. c.138, including notice, publication, and certified mailing of, and a public hearing on, such conversion; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the filing of a Home Rule Petition with the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to authorize the Board of Selectmen as the local licensing authority of the Town to issue up to two additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises pursuant to Section 15 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, such licenses to be non-transferable to any other person, corporation, or location, and to be issued by the Board of Selectmen subject to all other provisions of said Chapter 138; provided, however, that the General Court may make clerical or editorial changes of form only to the proposed special act, unless the Board of Selectmen approves such changes as are consistent with the public purposes of this petition prior to enactment by the General Court, or act thereon.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire, by purchase, gift, and/or eminent domain, on such terms as the Board of Selectmen deems appropriate, the land and/or permanent and temporary easements in, on, under, over, across and along certain parcels of land located on or near Leicester Street and Mill Street and approximately shown on the plan entitled "Massachusetts Department of Transportation Highway Division Plan and Profile of Leicester Street Bridge No. O-06-030 in the Town of Oxford Worcester County," dated 4-17-2024, last rev. 4-28-2025, prepared by Dawood, as it may be amended from time to time and/or incorporated into an easement plan, a copy of which has been placed on file with the Town Clerk, and land within 200 feet of said parcels, for the purpose of carrying out the Leicester Street Bridge Replacement Project as depicted on said plan and for any and all purposes and uses incidental or related thereto, including without limitation, for the construction, installation, inspection, maintenance, improvement, repair, replacement, and/or relocation of roadways, bridges, sidewalks, drainage, and utilities; and further to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, and/or borrow a sum of money for the purpose of providing for such acquisition, and paying any and all costs incidental or related thereto, including, without limitation, the cost of any land/easement acquisitions, appraisals, and surveys; and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into all agreements and take any and all actions as may be necessary or appropriate to effectuate the foregoing; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to file a petition with the General Court for special legislation to amend the Town Charter to delete from Chapter 5, Section 5-2-2 therein the language, “The town manager need not be a resident of the town when appointed, but he shall take up residence within eight months following his appointment”; provided, however, that the General Court may make clerical or editorial changes of form only to the proposed special act, unless the Board of Selectmen approves such changes as are consistent with the public purposes of this petition prior to enactment by the General Court; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will vote to amend Chapter XI – Motor Vehicle Access, Parking and Loading of the Town’s Zoning By-Laws, to insert additional language in Section 2.3.1, to delete and replace Section 3 in its entirety, and to delete and replace Section 7.3 in its entirety, as shown on the document on file in the Town Clerk’s office; or act thereon.

ARTICLE 13. To see if the Town will vote to amend Chapter XVI - Definitions of the Town’s Zoning By-Laws, to insert additional definitions in Section 2, to delete and replace several definitions within Section 2, and to delete redundant or duplicate definitions in Section 2, as shown on the document on file in the Town Clerk’s office; or act thereon.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at the Post Office on the Plains, the Post Office in North Oxford, Memorial Hall, Huguenot Steamer No. 2 and the Post Office in Rochdale in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of said meeting. HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of said meeting.
